The University of Cincinnati is a public college that was founded in 1819. UC's setting is an urban setting. For freshmen, UC requires an ACT and an SAT. The average ACT is a 25 and the average SAT is a 1700. UC accepted 12647 students which is 75.78% of the the students that applied. In-state tuition is \$9332, in-state flat fee is \$1678, room and board is \$10496, and books are estimated to be \$1480. In total, going to UC would cost around \$23000. 51% of students that applied for financial aid received financial aid. University of Cincinnati was ranked 64th top public school in America. UC also has a 1-1 ratio of males to females and student to faculty ratio is 17-1. 20% of students live on campus. UC is in the NCAA for sports like football, basketball, etc.
