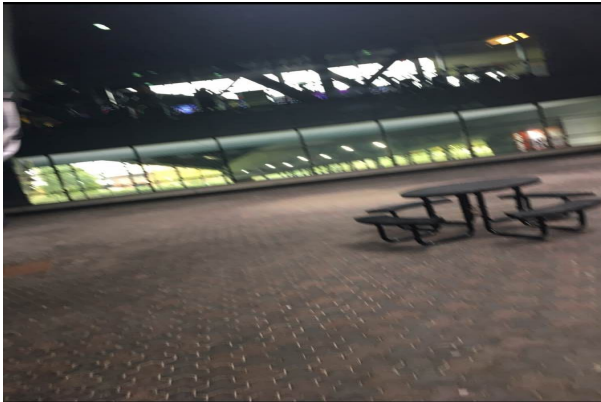


## My UC Visit

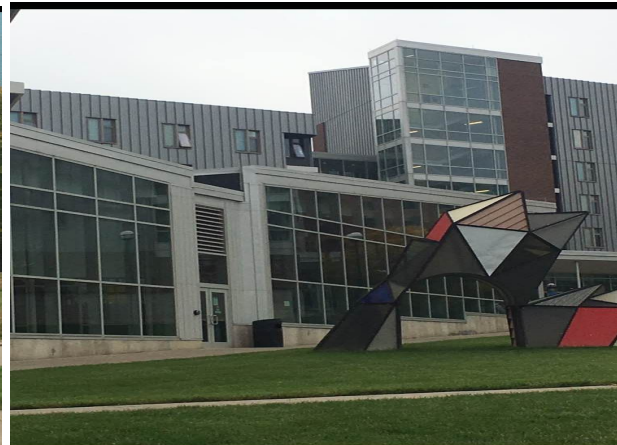
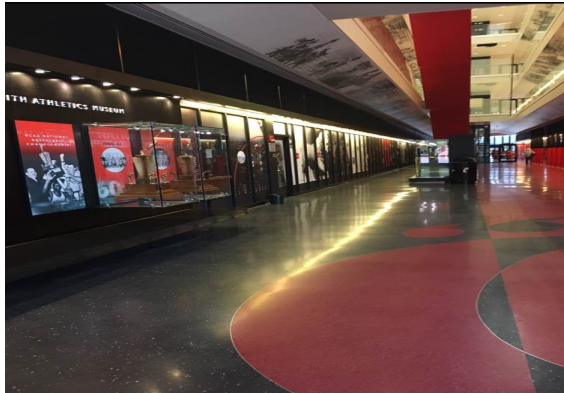


Nippert stadium. Located in the center of campus. Students can freely walk onto the field when not in use. New, \$10m renovation just added.

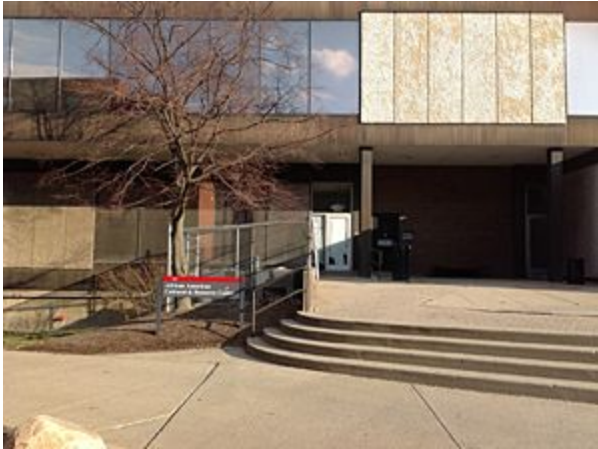
**Brand new mural that opened the same day I visited. UC had a school-wide contest to find the students that made the best mural. I met the student body president here.**
