University of Toledo welcomes about 23,000 students to campus each year, including 5,000 new undergraduates each Fall.

Student to Faculty ratio- 20:1

Division 1 school and member of the Mid-American Conference.

Established in 1872 by Jesup Scott

Originally a Private Art and Trade School only offering classes like Painting and Architectural Art.

The city actually opened without the permission of the city, so the school could only afford one teacher, for the couple of classes they offered, for 26 students. The school ended up closing in 1878 due to lack of funds.

The school opened back up in 1883, when the Board of Directors proposed that The University of Toledo to offer practical courses.

Today there are 140 Undergraduate Majors.

There is 9 different housing options:

- 1. **Parks Tower:** 2-person bedrooms with community bathrooms, all freshmen
- 2. Ottawa East and West: a 4-person dorm
- 3. **Academic House**: ranges from 2-4 persons bedroom with a community bathroom
- 4. **Horton International House:** 4-6 person suites with community kitchens on each floors and furnished rooms.
- 5. **McComas Village**: Townhouses for 7 sororities and fraternities, featuring living rooms, dining areas, full kitchen, laundry rooms, and 2-3 persons bedrooms.
- 6. **Presidents Hall**: 6-persons suites
- 7. **Living Learning Communities**: on-campus housing based upon students with similar interests or academic interest living together.
- 8. **Honors Academic Village:** suite-style apartments with a fitness center.
- Mackinnon/Scott/Tucker: One- person double sized bedrooms with community bathrooms.
