

Cedric- How To Earn Your Pharmacy Degree

To become a pharmacist you have to go to undergraduate school for about two to four years. To meet the requirements for Pharmacy the student must take organic chemistry, human anatomy and physiology, molecular and cellular biology, microbiology, statistics, calculus and English. After you are done with your years of undergraduate school you can apply for the four year pharmacy doctoral program. During school for your doctor's degree, you must complete at least 2000 hours of clinical experience.

After you graduate from the doctoral program, you have to fulfill the state requirements for the state you will be practicing in. You have to pass three test for licensing examinations, you must pass the North American Pharmacist Licensing Exam, the Multistate Pharmacy Jurisprudence Exam, and the Written and Practical exam. After that you go into your postdoctoral training for about a year or two.
