Equipment Used by Construction Electricians

Poles boots: used by every CE to climb electrical poles that they have erected and must now climb the 35 foot wooden pole with only these boots and begin wiring.





Uniforms: there are two types of uniforms that Seabees can wear: type II and type III. Type II is the one they use for desert environments and III for more woodland type environments. The work uniform also includes a bullet resistant vest as Seabees are deployed to combat zones half the time.

M4A1: every Sailor is trained in combat;
however, the Seabees get extensive combat
training due to the fact that they assist marines
and army men quite regularly in combat zones.
The marines and army watch over Seabees as
they build in combat zones. The M4A1 is the
basic rifle assigned to Seabees in combat zones.



Electricians bag: every CE is assigned an assortment of small tools including wire cutters, drill, lights, walkie talkies, screwdrivers and screws, box cutters, duct tape, sharpies. Every construction electrician is trained to use every one of these tools and are required to recognize them know how to work them and the best situations to use them in.



Hard hat: CE's work in dangerous environments where welding, cutting, and heavy equipment usage takes place, so a hard hat is need to protect the individual to the fullest. The hard hat is only worn by seabees that are not in combat zones. Seabees who are in combat zones are required to wear a standard combat worn helmet to protect against projectiles.
