Ohio State started out with a class of 24 students and now 2015's enrollment was 58,663. In 1891, the school saw the beginning of its law school named the Moritz College of Law. After a while it would get the colleges of medicine, dentistry, optometry, veterinary medicine, commerce, and journalism, and in 1916 the university would be

accepted into the Association of American Universities. The cost of tuition is in-state \$10,037 Out-of-state \$29,229.
