

Miami University

On February 2, 1809 Miami University was founded when the Legislature passed “An Act to Establish the Miami University”. The township was originally called “College Township” then renamed Oxford, Ohio in 1810. The first day of classes at Miami were on November



1, 1824. They started with 20 students and 2 faculty members as well as the Bishop. Classes Miami had were Greek, Latin, Algebra, Geography and Roman History. The University offered a Bachelor of Arts. An "English Scientific Department" was started in 1825, which studied modern languages, applied mathematics, and political economy as training for more professions. It offered a certificate upon completion of coursework, not a full diploma. In 1873, Miami was shut down because of a “Snow ball rebellion”. Later, it was reopened in 1885 and continuing to stay open to current day.

For Miami University the application deadline is February 1st. An application cost \$50. Out of 25,301 applications they received only 16,657 were actually accepted into Miami. Which is only 65.84% that are accepted. There are many requirements that need to be on your application. This includes: ACT scores, High school GPA, class rank, test scores and many others. Tuition for a full year is \$13,522 unless you live out of state the cost is much more at \$29,640. Grants, scholarships and loans can be offered by Miami.

Miami University is the college of my choice. I’ve always wanted to go there since I was little. I’ve been on the campus multiple times and think it’s absolutely gorgeous. I hope to continue my education at Miami University in the near future.
