

My college of interest is Central State University. This is a historically black college located in Xenia, Ohio. It was established in 1887 by Wilberforce University after Ohio passed legislation combining their Combined Normal and Industrial departments. This entity was still under Wilberforce but had a separate board of trustees and eventually expanded into being a 4 year program. In 1947, the department legally split, changing its name to Central State College after 5 years of existence. After continued growth over the years, the program finally achieved university status in 1965.

To apply directly from high school, you must have an overall GPA of a 2.2 and taken the ACT or SAT. ACT scores must be a minimum of 16 and SAT in order to get accepted.
