Kent State was established on May 19th, 1910

History behind Kent:

1913- First full year of academics with 144 students enrolled

1924- Dr. Arville C. DeWeese organized the health and physical education departments

1935- Kent State finally becomes an University

1940 to 1943- The enrollment dropped from 2,707 in 1940 to 777 in 1943 due to the students going to war.

1955- Post war boom continues with 6,000 growing population of students

1965- Honors College comes to campus

1970- 12 story library opens up and on May 4th, 1970 there was a demonstration protesting the U.S invasion of Cambodia where 4 students were killed and 9 were wounded.

1984- Thomas Jefferson a former student takes bronze medal at the 1984 Olympic games in Los Angeles

1999- Rec center opens
