

My Experience Visiting MUM

On my guided tour the instructor first talked about how much MUM would cost in one full year. I learned that as of right now it costs \$5200 for one full year at MUM. The instructor then led us outside to walk around the campus. The campus is surrounded by trees and it's very quiet there. The instructor also showed us many areas that students use as study areas- both inside and outside. We started in the main building called Johnston Hall and then headed to the Science and Technology building. The Science and Technology building is mainly where you take the classes to become a nurse or go into the medical field. The instructor talked to us about having a certain number of class hours per semester; most students take 12 hours worth of classes each semester. We walked into Levey Hall which is where Biology and Anatomy classes are held and is also one of the rooms in Levey Hall is where you can take the ACT. The campus has a computer lab and library to use whenever students need. There are a couple recently built/finished buildings at MUM.

After the tour I felt more comfortable about my future in college. The classes hold up to 25 people, so that's a better way to get help from teachers.
