
Miami University of Middletown Information

- MUM is the oldest regional campus of Miami University.
- It may also be to most forested college campus in the U.S.
- Its educational institutes were established in 1966.
- 2700 undergraduates and 300 graduates currently attend MUM.
- This regional college offers a bachelor's and associate's degrees, beginning course for 4
 year degrees, a certificate program, MBA, and MEd.
- MUM also offers 8 sports including volleyball, basketball, softball, and baseball.
- One full year at MUM currently costs \$5200.
- FAFSA deadline for regional campuses is February 1st.
- Deadline to apply for the fall of 2017 is August 1 of 2016.
- If you get a ACT score of 23 and a G.P.A. of 3.5 you can get \$1,000 off your tuition.
- You can apply to receive a tutor or apply to become a peer tutor.
- Miami Regionals offer the ability to go from a RN to a BSN online with classes.
- MUM has one the best RN-BSN nursing programs.
- To complete the degree for the bachelor in nursing degree you must complete 12 nursing courses. Those who complete the 12 courses are known to become nurse practitioners or clinical nurse specialists.
- Miami Regionals don't offer a 4 year master's degree in nursing but the department of nursing does offer pre-licensure, full time, 4 year curriculum.
